Even better, your donors who are also taxpayers can Gift Aid their donations, allowing us to claim an extra 25% of their donated amount from the HMRC – at no cost to them.

Our work in Borneo....


Every tree that falls results in the destruction of precious biodiversity that supports wildlife ranging from tiny frogs and unique plants to pygmy elephants, sun bears and our own relative, the orangutan. Read it a second time, and we'll lose the same amount of rainforest again. And we'll continue losing rainforest at that rate: so these amazing species are losing their homes right now, pushed to the brink of extinction.

This is why Chester Zoo is working to support projects in Borneo aimed at the reforestation of these critical areas, providing wildlife corridors enabling the animals to move between habitats safely. We carry out this work in collaboration with landowners, working towards a sustainable future for the rainforests of Borneo.

Non sustainable palm oil production is at the heart of the problem with huge areas of natural rainforest being destroyed to provide land for lucrative oil palm plantations. Not all palm oil is bad though and Chester Zoo has been working hard both at home and further afield to show that a goal of using only **sustainable palm oil** is the way forward for us all. In 2019 we were hugely proud when Chester became the world's first sustainable palm oil city, showing just what can be achieved when we all work together and believe in something.


And work together we must or our children will see even more ruinous destruction and the extinction of some species in their lifetime.

Your fundraising will enable us to plant trees in a former oil palm plantation, but that's not all – we will also be protecting and monitoring these reforested areas. Most importantly, these trees will form a wildlife corridor along the Kinbanatang river between two fragments of protected rainforest, where isolated groups of orangutans currently live, so expanding their rainforest habitat and allowing them to thrive once more.

We are so excited to be able to offer you the chance to have a concrete impact on an issue that can seem overwhelming. Any money you raise for us will be converted into trees which will be nurtured, protected, planted, and monitored. They will form a home for wildlife, they will fight climate degeneration, they will ensure that this corner of the world is safe for the future.



FUNDRAISING GUIDE

Our Fundraising Guide is here to keep you safe and secure. So you can...

...ENJOY EVERY MINUTE of making a real difference.

Fundraising during coronavirus

- Fundraise with the same precautions as you would under normal circumstances!
- Don't invite digital strangers into your home, and make sure children are supervised when using online communications apps.
- Use a trusted platform to collect your donations (like JustGiving or VirginMoney).
- Please respect all the changing government guidelines surrounding coronavirus, including social distancing, group sizes & any other guidance we all need to adhere to.
- Respect everybody. Don't pressure people into donating, and don't make people feel guilty if they can't sponsor you.

Safety first

- Ensure that you only collect donations and sponsorship from people that you know and trust.
- Make sure children are supervised and do not collect money on their own or from strangers.
- If you are aged under 18, please include a parent, guardian or teacher in all your plans and communications.
- If you are holding an event, make sure the venue is safe and don't forget crowd control.
- Think about security if you are carrying money around.
- Make sure adequate first aid cover is available and fire regulations are in place for larger events.





Getting it right...

Legalities

- Do not do house to house or street collections this is illegal without a local authority licence.
- If you plan to fundraise on private property, make sure you have permission from the owner first and find out what insurance you may need. This includes fundraising at places such as your school, college or workplace. You can also ask us for a Letter of Authority so we can confirm that you are fundraising in aid of Chester Zoo. Drop us a line to fundraising@chesterZoo.org
- If holding a large event, check with your local authority, on whether you need to obtain any special licences (e.g. public entertainment, collection or alcohol licences).
- If you intend on doing a raffle/lottery, check the rules with your local authority or the Gambling Commission.
- Chester Zoo cannot accept liability for any fundraising activity or event you undertake.
 Most venues will have insurance to cover events organised on their premises but please check that any liabilities to the public are covered to protect yourself as well as others.
- Chester Zoo is registered with the Fundraising Regulator and all our fundraisers must adhere to the Fundraising Regulator Code of Practice.

- Plug you on social media there are just too many of you!!! But if you post and tag us in we'll be sure to reply and like!
- Provide free tickets or competition prizes as much as we'd love to, we just don't have the financial resources and we must be fair to everyone
- Help you jump the queue for zoo tickets –
 we're on strict numbers for safety reasons, and
 once they're gone, we're up to capacity
- We can't sell things in the shop for you but we're always happy to send your details to our Buyers for future reference
- Exchange donations for adoptions. Adoptions still support us massively, but if you want to fundraise to purchase adoptions please set up a JustGiving Crowdfunder and be super clear about how you're going to spend the money raised in your story.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is brilliant. If you are a taxpayer, we can ask HMRC to pay us 25% on top of your original donation, and it doesn't cost you a penny. That means that if you are a taxpayer and you have donated £10, we can claim an extra £2.50 if you tick the Gift Aid box. So your gift of £10 has magically become £12.50 for us.

How can I transfer donations to you?

We have a number of ways we can accept donations.

Just Giving These donations are paid to us directly – you don't have to worry about a thing!

Online. For online donations, please speak to the Fundraising team via **fundraising@chesterzoo.org** so that we can track your donation.

Can I do a street collection?

You can't collect money on the street or in a public place without a licence.

If you are fundraising in a private place (for example, an office) then this is fine as long as you have written permission. You can also ask us for a Letter of Authority so we can confirm that you are fundraising in aid of Chester Zoo.

Spread the word of your fundraising on social media - it's a great way of getting the word out about your activity and directing people to your Just Giving page!
