Name	Linne's Two-toed Sloth
Scientific Name	<i>Choloepus didactylus</i>
Threats (why they're at risk)	They are hunted sometimes
Distribution (where they live)	Northern South America
Habitat (what they live in)	High in the rainforest canopy where they can hang from branches
Diet/Feeding strategy (what they eat and how they eat it)	They mostly eat berries, twigs, fruit and leaves from the trees. But they can eat insects too.
Social behaviour (how they live)	They live alone, but more than one female can share the same tree.
Males and females	Males and females are similar and it's hard to tell the difference between them
Lifespan (how long they live for)	up to 27 years in the wild
Number of young (how many babies)	1
Interesting fact	They only come down to the ground to change trees or to poo, which only happens once a week. Sloths are good swimmers
