QUESTION 5

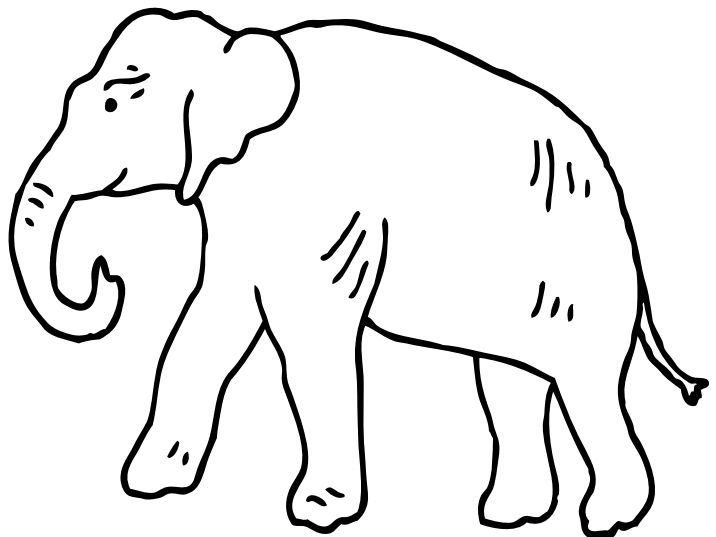
Poaching is a big problem for African elephants, what is one of the biggest threats to Asian elephants?
