What is a baby kangaroo called?

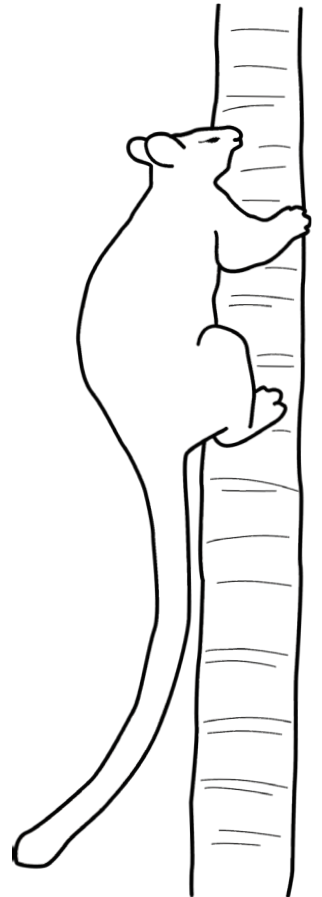
