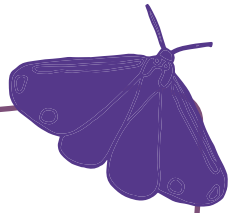

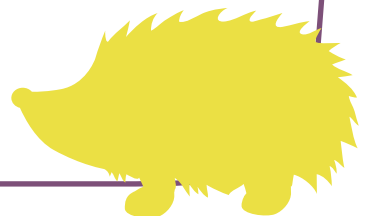
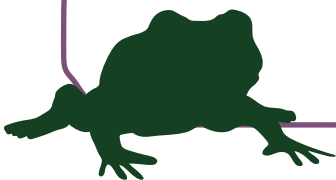

Glossary of key words

Decline

Something that becomes smaller, fewer or less.

Habitat

The type of natural environment in which a particular species of organism lives.

Habitat
fragmentation

Where large areas of habitat is transformed into a number of smaller patches of habitats with nothing to link them. Species can become isolated in these small areas.

Insecticide

A chemical used to kill insects, usually to stop crops being eaten.

Invasive species

A species that is not native to a specific location (an introduced species) and can have a negative impact on the environment or to human health.

Native species

Originated in their location naturally and without the involvement of human activity or intervention.

Population

All the organisms of the same group or species who live in a particular geographical area.

Rural habitat

Areas that are mainly countryside.

Urban habitat

Areas that are built up including cities and towns.
