PASSERINE VS NON-PASSERINE

The most prominent characteristic shared by all passerine birds is the arrangement of toes: **three toes facing forward and one backward**, which allows the bird to easily cling to perches, including branches and tree trunks. These birds also have an adaptation in their legs that gives them extra strength for perching. It is this toe arrangement and gripping posture that makes all passerines "perching" birds.
