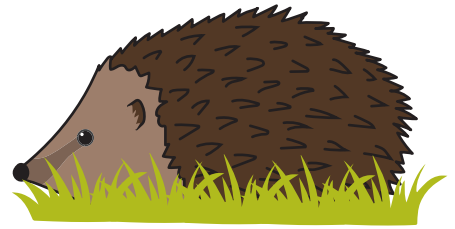


# LEARN AT CHESTERZOO

## MAKE A WILDLIFE WALKWAY IN YOUR GARDEN

What changes can we make to our gardens and green spaces to make it easier for our wandering wildlife to get around?



### Provide holes in your fences

So hedgehogs and other small mammals can move through and access other gardens (check with your neighbours first!).



### Provide a source of water

A shallow and wide dish will provide a drinking source and a place for bathing.



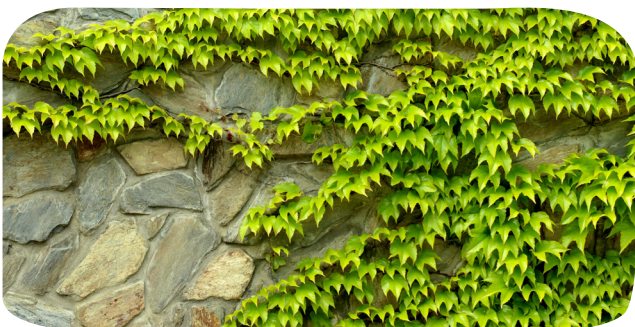
### Leave areas of your garden to grow wild

This provides places to hide and find food for wandering mammals, like hedgehogs.



### Don't be hasty in cleaning up fallen leaves

Pile these up to provide a place for hedgehogs to sleep in. It will also attract insects for them to snack on.



### Add climbing plants on your bare fences or garden walls

These act as a ladders for creatures to climb in and out of your garden.
