MAKE A WILDLIFE WALKWAY IN YOUR GARDEN

What changes can we make to our gardens and green spaces to make it easier for our wandering wildlife to get around?





Provide holes in your fences

So hedgehogs and other small mammals can move through and access other gardens (check with your neighbours first!).



Provide a source of water

A shallow and wide dish will provide a drinking source and a place for bathing.



Leave areas of your garden to grow wild

This provides places to hide and find food for wandering mammals, like hedgehogs.



Don't be hasty in cleaning up fallen leaves

Pile these up to provide a place for hedgehogs to sleep in. It will also attract insects for them to snack on.



Add climbing plants on your bare fences or garden walls

These act as a ladders for creatures to climb in and out of your garden.
